- a. Grant Proposals: River Day celebration The Barkhamsted School proposal request for \$10,000 Discussion: we cannot fund the ice cream, and also think we should not fund the T-shirts. Important for River Day to have other funding sources to make it viable and sustainability in the long-term. Recommendation to the full committee to support it at \$5,000. Laura/Roger to follow up.
- **b.** Paddling Film Fest CCK -request for \$695 Discussion: Laura abstained due to CCK wanting this event to be a fundraiser for FRWA. Need more specifics on if all of the proceeds go to FRWA, and how this event is different from the Wild & Scenic Festival. Andrew to follow up with Melissa at CCK for these details.
