# Minutes Resource Stewardship subcommittee Tuesday, July 2, 2024, 4:30 PM Zoom

## 1) Invasive Plant Management

Laura has been in contact with Jerry Milne, DEEP forester. He has provided a map to indicate specifically where invasive plant removal should be targeted along West River Road near American Legion State Forest. He identified several species that need to be targeted. Since the area extends 6800 ft, more than a mile, and 15 feet wide. The invasives removal project will likely be ongoing over several years. Laura suggested that we begin with bittersweet. A map is provided. The committee's preference is that the invasives be removed using manual removal and if herbicides are necessary – cut and paint. Jerry Milne provided a list of approved contractors who do invasive plant removal. Laura will contact companies and request bids.
